

Punkin Chunkin Official Rules

US 96 Punkin Chunkin event will take place Saturday, Nov 3rd at McClain General Store. The registration will open up at 9:30 am and will close promptly at 10:30 am. Anyone who is not in the registration line by 10:30 am will not be allowed to enter the contest. \$5 donation to Children's Hospital is encouraged and will get the first 100 participants a special Punkin Chunkin T-shirt.

Entrants will throw plastic pumpkin buckets at targets painted on the ground in the grassy area adjacent to the family area at McClain. The targets will have point values assigned to each of the rings that make up the target. Each entrant will throw three pumpkin buckets. Whichever ring the pumpkin bucket lands in will be the point value the entrant gets for that throw. The three throws will be added together and that will be the final score for that entrant. The plastic pumpkin bucket must be more than 50% in the ring to be awarded that point value. The decision of the judges, McClain, and New South Radio, Inc. is final and the rules may be changed at any time.

There will be two categories; 1). Children 12 and under and 2). Adults 13 years of age and up. If an entrant is under the age of 18 their parent or custodial guardian must be present at the event and sign the official rules and entry form stating that, should their child win, the \$1000 check will be made out to the parent or custodial guardian and they are responsible for all taxes as would be any other \$1000 winner. The parent also agrees to all the rules and legal terms as they pertain to themselves and their participating child. The prize for the winner in the child category is a \$250 shopping spree at McClain General Store.

In the event of a tie, there will be a "chunk off". Entrants with the high scores will do the process over again until there is a definitive winner. The winner will receive \$1000 in the form of a check. The check will take 10-15 business days to get issued and the winner must pick it up at the New South Radio Studios located at 265 Highpoint Dr. Ridgeland, MS 39157. The winner must fill out W9 forms when picking up the check and are responsible for all taxes on the winnings.

As a condition of being allowed to participate in the Punkin Chunkin contest, the undersigned participant releases and holds harmless New South Radio, Inc. (d.b.a. The Radio People and WUSJ FM) McClain, and Ritchie Automotive and all entities' agents, owners, officers, employees, successors and assigns from liability for any losses, claims, injuries, illnesses, damages, or other costs arising out of or as a result of the undersigned's participation in the contest. As a condition of being allowed to participate in the contest entrants agree to have their likeness used for promotional purposes by each of the above-named entities.
